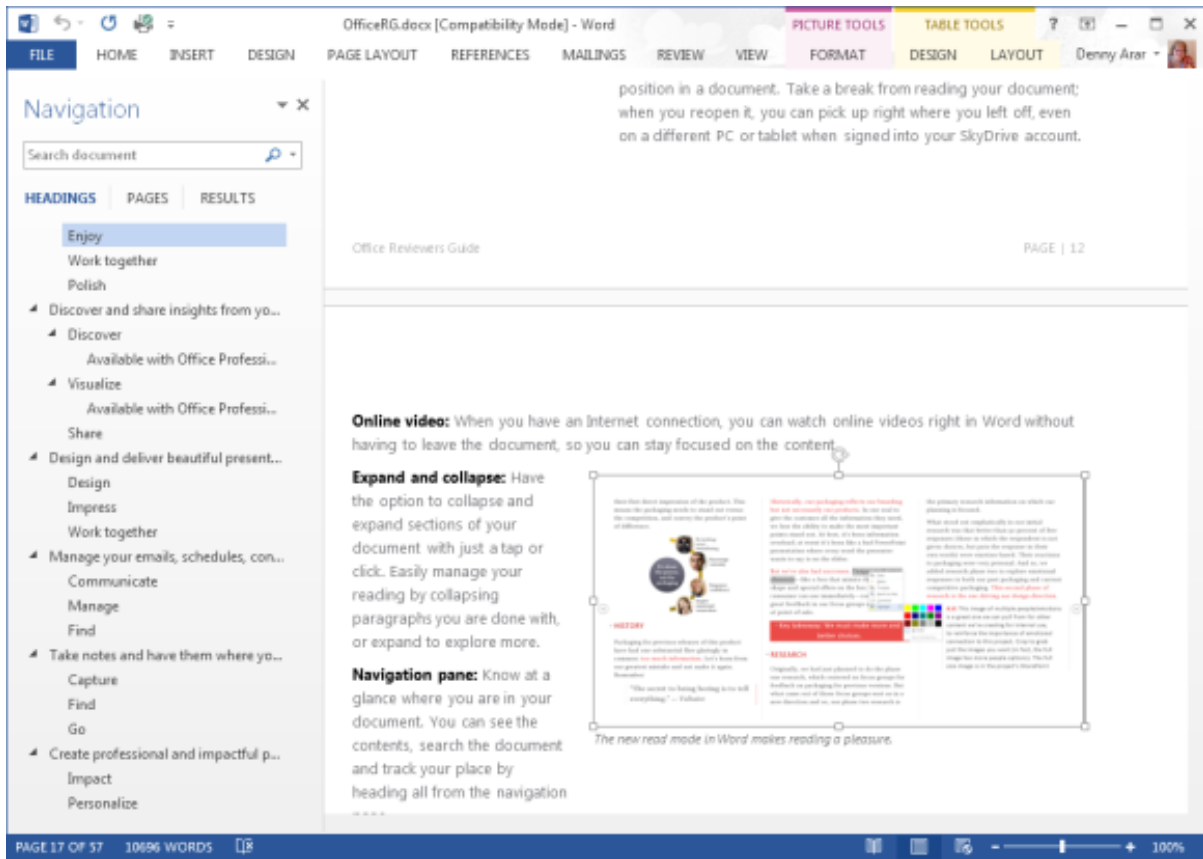

A neurone circuit that mimics the processing of human body odours by olfactory sensory neurons is presented. The circuit is inspired by the mechanism of olfactory receptors in the primary olfactory area in vertebrate brains, which is usually assumed to underlie a mechanism that extracts temporal features of odours. The single unit is a simplified and abstract model of the olfactory sensory neurons in the insect olfactory system. Its function is to extract temporal features of odours through encoding of their occurrence frequencies in time, instead of being a dedicated neuron for processing odours, as usually assumed. It operates in the time domain, in a way similar to that of any other single-unit circuit, but it is directly inspired by the processing mechanism in the primary olfactory area of vertebrate brains. A neural network including neurons based on the model is used to predict time-dependent odour perception for five synthetic body odours, in comparison to our own measured psychophysical results.
